LIFE @ STEP UP

Experiential learning is an engaged learning process whereby students "learn by doing" and by reflecting on the experience. Learning that is considered "experiential" contain all the following elements: Reflection, critical analysis and synthesis. With the help of experiential learning students are able to connect theories and knowledge learned in the classroom to real-world situations. Moreover, it encourages the student to have first-hand experiences with the materials, rather than learning through someone else's experiences in textbook or lecture. Every Stepian got ample opportunities to showcase and reflect what they had learnt during regular classes.

Brain Teaser- In this, kids learn brain training to exercise core cognitive skills. The brain uses the core cognitive skills to think, learn, read, remember reason, pay attention, and solve problems. Regular brain teaser sessions are scheduled for students of Grade I-III which help to improve ability to learn, problem solving skills, and memory as they use specific neural networks. These exercises also help in making great coordination between left and right-side brain of the kids.

In Brain Teaser classes, we also teach how to develop optimism as Positive Thinking leads to enhanced creativity, staying focused, problem-solving skills and overall mental productivity.

Project-based learning is an instructional approach designed to give students the opportunity to develop knowledge and skills through engaging projects set around challenges and problems they may face in the real world. By bringing real-life context and technology to the curriculum through a PBL approach, students are encouraged to become independent workers, critical thinkers, and lifelong

learners.

Motor development means the physical growth and strengthening of a child's bones, muscles and ability to move and touch his/her surroundings. A child's motor development falls into two categories: Fine Motor and Gross Motor. Fine motor skills refer to small movements in the hands, wrists, fingers, feet, toes, lips and tongue. Gross motor skills involve motor development of muscles that enable babies to hold up their heads, sit and crawl, and eventually walk, run, jump and skip. At Step Up School, the main focus of Preprimary Wing is to develop these Motor skills in our students through various activities and hence strengthening the bones and muscles of the above-mentioned body parts that ultimately helps in good handwriting, enhanced eye- hand coordination, better sitting, standing and walking posture etc.

Virtual Reality (VR) and Augmented reality (AR) provide a completely new way to engage with students and can increase their retention of information. So, keeping in mind Step Up School has introduced AR and VR to the students.

Understanding the revolution in technology and education, **Coding** for Grade IV-VII and **Artificial Intelligence** for Grade VIII-X were introduced as a part of curriculum. Coding and AI for students not only helps improve their mathematics, writing and communication skills but also give them valuable skills in life and promotes creativity.

Olympiad exams are all about bringing the best out of children. These are national and international competitions that prove beneficial in the long run. Some of the prominent benefits include problem-solving ability, analytical thinking and testing students' aptitude. Keeping this in consideration, regular Olympiad classes were organized for the students to provide them the clarity of concepts, to encourage self-learning and to boost their confidence.

Step Up School believes everyone is a genius and, if given the opportunity, "everyone's genius can shine." That's what we hope to help students through "Pure Genius Lab". Math & Science is everything around us if we think creatively about it. "So many kids don't think they can do math/science because they don't have a kit. We opened **Pure Genius Lab** for grade 1 to 5, because Step Up School want kids to have these learning opportunities with some learning tools to understand the concept through activities."

Motor development involves physical activities, and a child's brain is a big part of it. It takes the brain and the body's muscles to allow these skills to develop, connect and build with all other parts of a child's development —language, socio-emotional, and behavioral. **Happiness Lab** at Step Up School is designed in order to support the development of these skills in a child. The lab has array of equipments, tools and games that are vital for the Fine and Gross motor development in our little ones.

With the aim to discover the value of unity and to develop social skills, various clubs have been set up by the school. School clubs create small communities. Club activities help students develop sense of unity and teamwork, learning how to work with others in reaching the same goals. Clubs enable students to meet, mix, and collaborate with other students from different backgrounds in a different environment. They are pushed outside of their comfort zone and encouraged to socialise with people they are not very familiar with. The various clubs included are: **Eco Club, Food and Nutrition Club, Science Club, Literary Club and Community Service Club.**

Public speaking gives students a stage to turn into orators, allowing them to influence and inspire others with the power of persuasion. It improves overall communication, enhances social skills, enables students to cope up better with the society and function in day-to-day life. Step Up School has a Public Speaking classes incorporated in its curriculum to improve Student's confidence, body language on

stage, oratory skills, presentation etc. At Step Up School, we continuously work on enhancing the Public Speaking skills in our students of Grades Nursery to V.

Step Up School is known for complete development of the child. We not only emphasise on academics but also on the **co-curricular activities** like dance, music, art and craft. Our meritorious students are working on sculptures, lippan art and clay modelling. At the same time, they are getting valuable knowledge of different Raags, theory of music and how to write notation. We do have a wonderful school band and students are learning both acoustic and electronic instruments. When it comes to dance, our children are getting opportunity to learn different dance forms and style like Zumba, classical, folk and freestyle.

It is imperative for schools to have the latest and high-quality **Science lab** these days. In order to understand its concept of science, one has to look beyond the books and conventional classroom teaching. Effective teaching and learning of science involve seeing, handling and manipulating real objects and materials. Step Up school combine classroom teaching with laboratory experiments to ensure that their students grasp each and every concept thoroughly. Children are able to retain the knowledge for longer when they see the experiments being performed in front of their eyes. Science lab equipment allow students to interact directly with the data gathered. They get a first-hand learning experience by performing various experiments on their own.

Value based morning assemblies are a regular feature of each day at step up school. School Assemblies provide ample opportunities for all our students to come forth with self-courage and express their abilities of public speaking, reading, thought sharing etc. Cultural activities include celebration of different national and religious festivals like Diwali, Dusshera, Basant Panchami, Guru Nanak Jayanti, Christmas, and so on that made every child aware of our rich cultural heritage. All the festivals were celebrated with great zeal and enthusiasm which included an array of activities for our Stepians.

So, the school arranges many webinars and workshops every year and in 2023 it was in virtual mode directed by CBSE and other agencies. Periodical assessments and evaluations were carried out to track students' progress, and updates were consistently communicated to parents through Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTM). Teachers also organized subject enrichment activities in alignment with CBSE guidelines.
