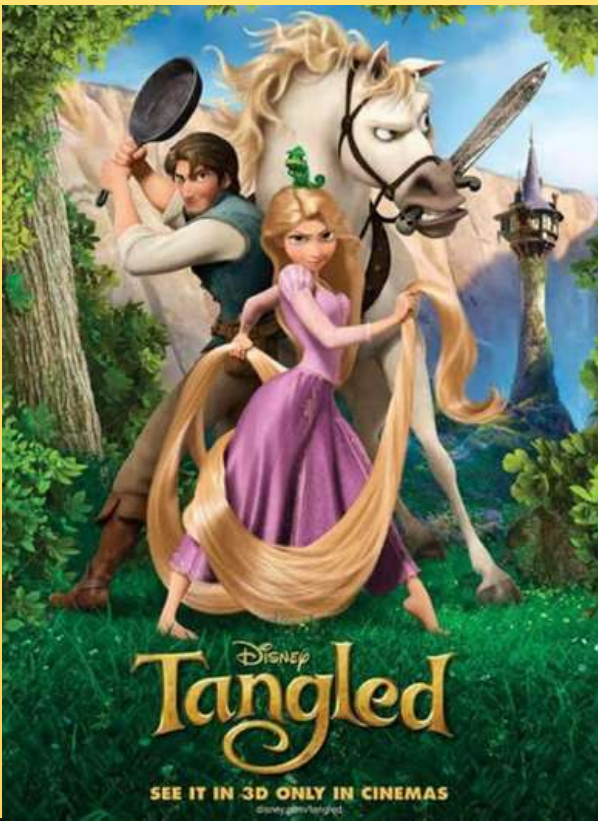
RISING INDIA EXHIBITION AT HRIT CAMPUS

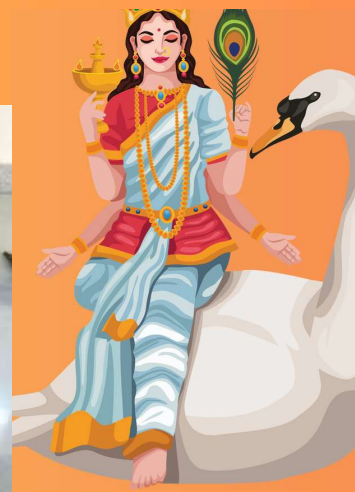
MERRY CHRISTMAS

BASANT PANCHMI

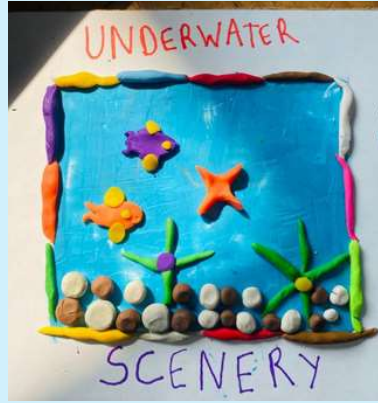
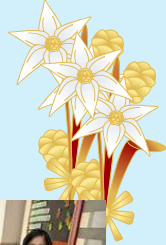

SPORTS DAY



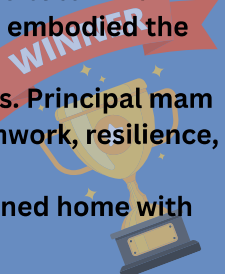
